

# SCTC CODE OF CONDUCT

SCTC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. SCTC believes that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with SCTC should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of all others. As a member of SCTC you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

## General Conduct

- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, sexual orientation, cultural background or religion.
- All members must play within the rules and respect officials from both the Club and the Tennis Centre and their decisions.
- Members must pay the appropriate court fees before going onto court.
- Members must similarly pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Members are responsible for the conduct of any guests and will be responsible for their behaviour.
- Members must observe the Club's Code of Conduct in any dealings with junior members.
- Swearing is not acceptable.
- Verbal and physical abuse of staff and other users will not be tolerated at any time and may lead to prosecution and a disqualification of the member.

## Care of the courts – these are your courts, look after them!

- All litter must be disposed of in the bins provided.
- Members should not ride bikes, use roller blades or skates or skateboards on the court surface.
- Members must wear non-marking shoes on court.
- Members are not allowed to smoke inside the pavilion or on court, no naked flames are allowed.
- Members are not allowed to consume food on the courts.
- No glass bottled or glass containers will be allowed on any of the pitches within the boundary fence at any time.

**Commercial dealings** Members should not conduct business for money, including services such as coaching, racket restringing or selling of equipment, without prior approval from the Centre Manager. Any member suspecting that unauthorised activity is taking place should inform Centre or Club Staff.

The Club reserves the absolute right to end membership at any time in the event of any breach of these terms and conditions without notice or payment or any compensation to the member.
