# Rules, Information & Conditions (please keep a copy for your records)

1. All entrants must be a member of Southwark City Tennis Club to be eligible to play the tournament. (its easy to join! Please complete form on next page if you are not already a member of S.C.T.C).
2. This tournament will be run in strict accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis, the Rules of the LTA and the LTA Tournament Regulations, including the LTA Code of Conduct (as each may be amended from time to time).
3. Doping Statement: "I consent to participating in doping control procedures, if selected, undertaken by a doping control officer appointed by UK Sport".
4. Disciplinary Statement: "I acknowledge and agree that I am subject to the Rules and Regulations of the LTA (including, without limitation, the LTA's Tournament Regulations, Anti-Doping Programme, Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Procedures and the Regulations Concerning Match Fixing, Financial Speculation and Betting) and hereby fully and unconditionally submit to the jurisdiction and authority of the LTA".
5. Media Statement: "I consent to being involved in any publicity connected with LTA Staged or Supported Tournaments, including media interviews, photographs, TV footage and LTA research projects". Please inform the tournament organiser if you do not wish to be involved in such publicity.
6. British Tennis Membership: "I consent to the details provided on this entry form to be used to update my membership record".
7. Data Usage Statement: "I consent to the LTA and/or the organisers of LTA tournaments, from my geographical area, using the details provided on the entry form to communicate information about this and future tournaments, in my geographical area, via post/email or SMS".
8. All match results will be recorded and will count towards a player's LTA rating.
9. Competitors are limited to 4 events, of which 2 must be singles events.
10. Juniors, who are eligible, can enter a maximum of 3 junior events (2 singles / 1 doubles) and 1 adult event (at junior fee rate of £3) subject to parental consent and space in the draw.
11. Competitors may be required to play 4 or 5 matches in one day.
12. Players should enter doubles events with partners, but if they are unable to do so, the tournament committee will try to find partners.
13. Entries must be received by midday on 10th July 2010 and cannot be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee.
14. The Draw is scheduled to take place on the 11th of July 2010.
15. Entry fees cannot be refunded after the draws have been made.
16. The committee reserve the right to limit the entry in events and/or to cancel events if the number of entries is less than 8.
17. The committee reserve the right modify the programme in any way they consider proper, subject to compliance in all cases with the Rules & Regulations of the LTA and to refuse entry without stating a reason.
18. ITF Approved Balls will be used.
19. In the Open events and 14U, 16U & 18U singles age groups, matches will be 3 sets with the third set being a match tie-break (10 points with 2 clear) up to the Quarter Finals; from then on matches will be best of three tie-break sets.
20. In 12U and all doubles events, all matches will be 3 sets with a match tie-break.
21. Red, Orange and Green events will use the various standard formats as per the LTA Framework.
22. Tournament formats are subject to weather conditions, court availability and draw size.
23. Play will commence from 9.00am each day with knock-ups will be limited to 5 minutes, thank you.
24. All competitors must make sure they sign the attendance sheet on arrival each day and accept that they may be disqualified if not available when called upon to play.
25. The next day's Order of Play will be posted online each evening and at the Pavilion. Please check this or consult with referee before leaving each day.
26. The referee's decision shall be final in all matters in connection with the tournament. No complaint to the committee can be entertained unless made in writing and lodged with the organisers within 24 hours of the cause of complaint.
27. In addition to the code of conduct, we politely request all players and parents/guardians to show respect to the officials, the club, the staff, the courts and the traditions of tennis.
28. Recognised tennis footwear and tennis attire, which conforms to LTA regulations, must be worn.
